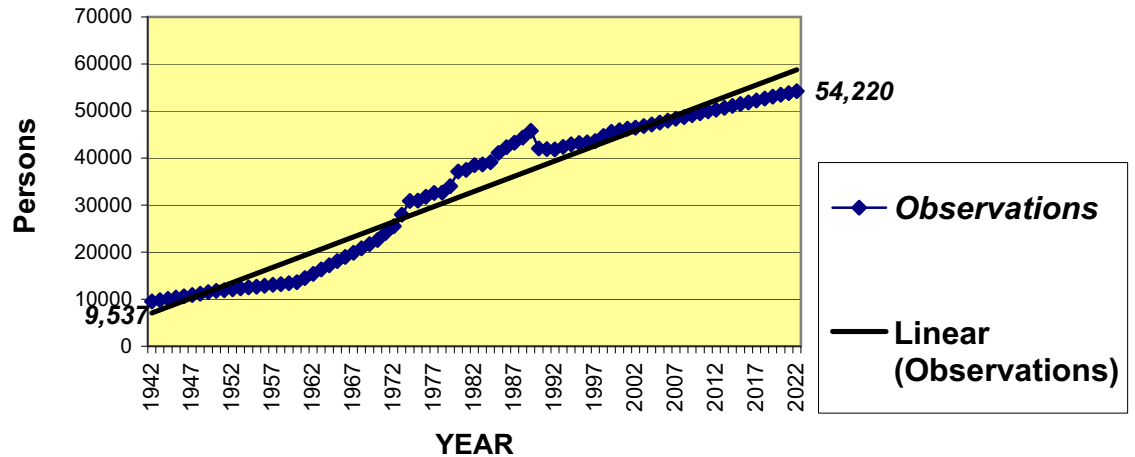

The following methodology was used to derive these projections:

- * Assume a 20 year projection time frame.
- * Use historical data from the Census Bureau and BEBR
- * Consider that the late 1980s BEBR estimates were trending higher than in the 1980s.
- * Changes in the slope of the graph indicate changes in the rate of growth.
- * Consider that growth rate in the 1990s is lower than in the 1980s.
- * Complete a 2021 projection using 10 and 20 years of historical data.
